IT Chair: Marshall W.

- Asset tagging efforts continue.
- Attended the finance committee workshop.
- At a recent District 40 monthly meeting, Marshall, with assistance from Betsy G., gave a presentation on the SETA IT Committee, their processes and general website overview it was well received by all attendees. Marshall hopes to continue similar presentations at other district meetings.

Webmaster: Jeff H. –

- There were 11 SETA website posting requests 6 page content/flyer updates and 5 meeting minutes.
- The last website backup was performed on 04/23/15.
- SETA website domain registration email notifications were received by and responded to via GoDaddy. ICANN, the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, requires that all domain registrars maintain correct and current WHOIS contact data for domain owners.

Postmaster: Kyna D.

- There were 9 email moderations, 7 password resets and 14 mail list/account changes.
- Since the last meeting, began work towards migration from Gossimer email hosting to 1 and 1 email hosting. Thus far, have completed the following:
 - o Populated Mail All lists (50)
 - o Changed passwords to default on 1 and 1 mail system (169)
 - o Removed mail forwarding to previous users
 - o Forwarded Webmail User Manual to webmaster for review and posting on the SETA website
- Moving forward, the schedule to complete migration is as follows:
 - o Send notification to all users regarding migration and steps to take, i.e., default password, downtime to expect, admin access to emails, and location of additional information (notification sent 05/24).
 - o Changing passwords on current mail system to allow for email export
 - o Import mails to 1 and 1
 - o Changing mail configuration (NS, A Records, and CNAME)

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- A payment was made to Gossimer for one (1) additional month on May 14, 2015. The next payment will be due on June 15, 2015. Anticipate the migration to be completed prior to that date.
- There were many automated email messages broadcast to SETA customers pertaining to subscription renewals to SETA group mail lists as a result of the above migration efforts.
- We are working towards a solution to a potential issue with 1and1 email SETA broadcast mail lists, i.e., SETA-ANNOUNCE, whereby, if someone were to Reply All to a broadcast message, it will go to all recipients.
- Customers will use the same email address and mail will go through Webmail1and1.com. Their User ID will remain the same and default passwords will be provided.

Support: Waco M. –

- Cable locks for laptops and projectors were purchased, totaling \$70.00.
- The Archives Committee projector is being evaluated for repair or replacement.

Review: Betsy G. – There were 15 emails rejected, mostly subscribe/unsubscribe messages. Still have one member causing SPAM issues possibly due to SETA email addresses in the person's personal email list (needs to be removed), 3 SPAM email rejects and 8 satisfactory SETA email requests.

Finance: Betsy G. –

• A copy of the IT Finance report was distributed and discussed, there were no charges applied in May. There was one change to the report for \$61 for the Gossimer email account payment. Mobile Beacon bill still has not been received. See below updated report.
