A need was identified by the CPC and PI committees to create a SETA home page focused on the suffering alcoholic and professionals demographic. Rick M. explained the background and where they are in the process. Vern demonstrated what he had developed so far via the GoToMeeting presentation. He referenced other web sites such as South Dakota Area 63 and AA.org as examples of how a home page focus might be. Discussion points:

- Suggested redirecting the current SETA home page as a link to another new home page of similar look and feel.
- New home page focus would be on the suffering alcoholic and area AA related information.
- This type of change would require workshops and voting at the Area level – this was understood by all.
- Demonstration of the proposed web page layout and functionality to other SETA members may be best accomplished via an unpublished link on the SETA website to this new home page. Jeff H. offered to post this page on the SETA website – Vern needs to provide the page to Jeff to make this happen then a communication to evaluators could be sent.
- Would PI/CPC champion this initiative?



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- Vern P. suggested we convert our SHTML pages to HTML for security reasons as they are more susceptible to malicious attack.
