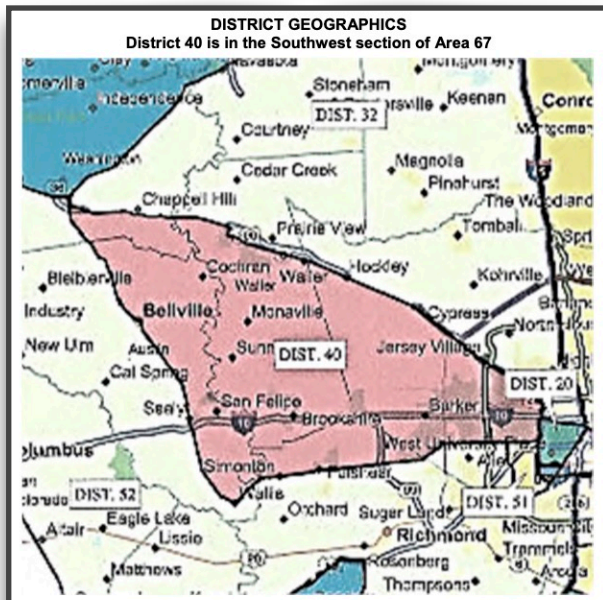
It's July already and have you been thinking about what service position you will stand for the next rotation?

final execution.

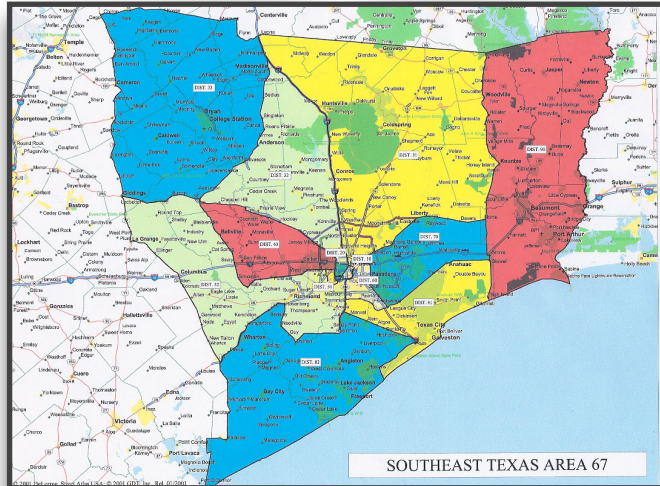
