That is not standard practice and is prohibited by our policies and procedures manual. Groups are the ultimate authority and decide to whom and how much they contribute. GSRs can ask groups: 1) Does your group have an Intergroup Delegate, each gets two, and 2)

Ask groups if they contribute. How do we bring in groups that don't participate? Bellaire has a few groups w/ reps. Coach will ask Men's group at Bellaire. Gordon made a motion for GSRs to ask their groups if they want district to contribute to Intergroup. Tom 2nd. Motion abandoned. Steven motions that we approach groups in our clubs that don't participate or contribute and that current GSRs relay this discussion to their groups. Loretta 2nd. All in favor.

Next District Workshop – Seminar on Spirituality. Newcomers can be uncomfortable with the "God" thing. Consider 1 athiest, 1 agnostic, 1 believer for speakers then open for questions. About 2 hours long w/ food. How newcomers can use the program best. According to AA Service Manual (pS32), under DCM duties, "Organizes workshops and/or sharing sessions on *service activities*." Ask speakers to share on how spirituality turns into service. Consider venues and promotion. There is a pamphlet, "Many Paths to Spirituality". Referred to Workshop Committee.

Final Agenda Items are out for April Conference. Background material is available, over 800 pages, through the DCMs.
