Troy B-D. Area 67 Delegate Report on Panel 69 GSO Conference 2019

Information in this report is from Troy's Power Point presentation which will be available on the SETA website (aa-SETA.org) just prior to the SETA Assembly October 5-6 2019.

Theme of the GSO was Our Big Book-80 Years, 71 Languages.

70th translation was in the unwritten Navaho language available on CD.

Next year's theme is 20/20 a Clear Vision for You.

The conference is composed of:

- 93 Delegates
- 25 Trustees/Directors
- 15 GSO/GV Staff
- 133 Total Voting Members

There are more delegates to help ensure a 2/3 majority vote on agenda items.

Stats for the attendees was presented i.e. breakdown of age, years sober, years in service etc.

Each first-time delegate is assigned a buddy. Troy's buddy was Jesus. His schedule was packed from 8:00AM until 9:00PM.

Troy presented the agenda item process. Starts with groups to district to areas then to GSO.

Fate of some agenda items for 2019

PASSED: CPC recommended to remove the phrase "Alcoholics Anonymous in your community" from their pamphlet.

NO ACTION: CFC to establish a database for facilities.

NO ACTION: Finance wanted to increase area delegate expenses.

PASSED: Increased maximum individual member begueaths to AA from 5K to 10K.

NO ACTION: reconsider maximum annual contribution from individual members.

NO ACTION: remove "alcoholism at large" i.e. treatment facilities from literature.

NO ACTION: publishing a 5th edition of the big book.

FAILED: adding language to the forwards.

FAILED: no change to the blue card, non-alcoholics can attend open meetings.

NO ACTION: to consider safety pamphlet.

PASSED: updates to the 12-step illustrated pamphlet.

PASSED: for PI purposes, actors used for full face.

Floor Actions

- 7
- 5 got debated
- FAILED: #1 recommit to draft a fourth edition of the Spanish BB. Reason the 5th edition English BB didn't pass.
- FAILED: #5 if item reaches "simple majority suggestion" phrase be prominently placed in the conference report.

Finances Highlight

<u>Troy was on the finance committee</u>

- Troy conveyed the issue with the amount of checks GSO is receiving from 7th tradition donations. 90% of groups are still sending checks. Checks take a lot of time to process. GSO averages 280 checks per day. Mail arrives 250 days per year. They are suggesting group treasurers consider online payments through the aa.org website.
- GSO is switching to an ERP (Enterprise resource planning) system. With the switch, each
 group will receive a new group number. When a group pays donations online, a new
 group number will be issued automatically.

- 8.4 million donations collected for 2019. Almost tied with 2017 which was a record year.
- Cost of services to the fellowship was 11.4 million which is an 11.4% increase from 2017.
- Only 41% of groups contribute to GSO. If more groups contributed AA could be self-supporting.
- Individual member cost is 8.06/year. New Challenge, each individual visit aa.org and donate \$8.06.
