



If a Conference Committee recommendation is approved, after full floor discussion, it becomes a <b>Conference Advisory Action</b> , which becomes binding when approved by the	General Service Board

Make Final Conference Agenda Items, and background material available to the entire Fellowship by February 1


(2) What problem does this proposed item address?
