

Read everything you can get your hands on.

If you do not have a service sponsor, get one, preferably a person who has held the position you are rotating into, but this is not a requirement. Also begin to study our Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts, read the Service Manual and discuss these topics with your service sponsor and anyone else to rope into it.

On a lighter note, don't forget to stay in the moment and have fun. Keep Rule 62 in the front of your psyche. None of us has ever done nor will anyone ever do one of these jobs perfectly. The nature of the spirit of rotation will always ensure that about the time we figure out what we are doing, it is time to rotate. Your time in your position will pass quickly, trust me about this. You are in for one heckuva ride, so enjoy.

Thank you for allowing me to be of service and represent you as your Area 67 Delegate for these last two years. It has been an honor, a privilege, a wonderful opportunity, and most importantly, it has truly been a joy!
